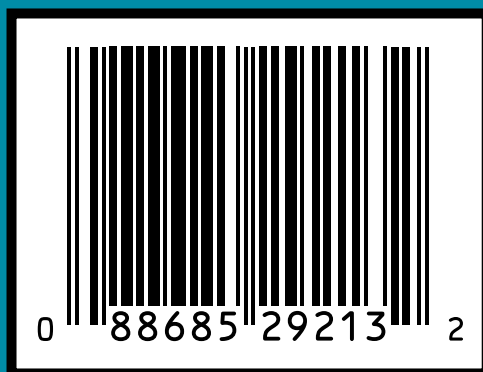

Directions for Successful Seeding

1. Buy the Best Seed

Greenview Grass Seed is consistently top rated in NTEP trials. No other brand contains as many top rated seeds. And with Greenview your seeds are always 99.9% weed free.

2. Prepare the Soil

A. New Lawns

- Loosen the top 2 to 3 inches of soil
- Remove debris – sticks, stones, etc.
- Break up dirt clumps larger than a half dollar
- Avoid too fine soil, small clumps are desirable
- Level areas where excess water might collect

TIP: Fertilize prior to seeding. Use Greenview Seed Accelerator or starter fertilizer. Don't use weed killers.

B. Existing Lawns

- Mow grass as short as possible
- Loosen top 1/4 inch of soil in bare spots
- Remove debris and dead grass
- Level areas where excess water collects

TIP: Use existing topsoil. Added soil may have weed seeds.

3. Plant Seeds

- Spread seed evenly by hand in small areas
- Use hand or lawn spreader in large areas
- Apply approximately 16 seeds per square inch or 8 seeds per square inch when overseeding an existing lawn

TIP: Too many seeds too close causes seedlings to fight for growth.

4. Cover Seeds

- Lightly drag seed bed so no more than 1/4 inch of soil covers seeds
- Cover seed bed with Greenview Seed Accelerator to hold seeds in place and to retain moisture

5. Water Often

- Keep seed bed moist to enhance germination
- Water lightly (don't saturate) and frequently (at least once daily) until new grass is two inches high
- Water new grass regularly to keep roots moist

6. Helpful Tips

Mowing

- Don't mow until new grass is three inches tall
- Cut and maintain at 2 1/2 inch height
- Keep mower blades sharp to avoid tearing

Greening

- Fertilize prior to seeding. Use Greenview Seed Accelerator or Starter Fertilizer
- Don't use a Weed & Feed until grass is established (3 mowings)
- Fertilize lawn spring and fall
- Green lawn in summer with Greenview PerkUp®

Weeding

- Wait 6-8 weeks after seeding to kill weeds
- Use Greenview Spring Fertilizer with Weed Control
