Directions for Successful Seeding

1. Prepare the Soil

A. New Lawns

- Loosen the top 2 to 3 inches of soil
- Remove debris sticks, stones, etc.
- Break up dirt clumps larger than a half dollar
- Avoid too fine soil, small clumps are acceptable
- Level areas where excess water might collect

B. Existing Lawns

- Mow grass as short as possible
- Loosen top 1/4 inch of soil in bare spots
- Remove debris and dead grass
- Level areas where excess water collects
- TIP: Use existing topsoil. Added soil may have weed seeds.

2. Plant Seeds

- Spread seed evenly by hand in small areas
- Use hand or lawn spreader in large areas

TIP: Too many seeds too close together causes seedlings to fight for room and nutrients. Grass may be weak or thin in these areas.

3. Cover Seeded Areas

Protecting newly seeded areas is one of the most important steps for seeding success when growing grass. • Lightly rake seed bed so no more than 1/4 inch of soil covers grass seed

• For best results, we recommend protecting the seeded area with GreenView Fairway Formula Seeding Success so you water less while the grass seed germinates successfully. The starter fertilizer in the biodegradable seeding mulch pellets is formulated to promote the development of strong roots so that the lawn section gets off to the right start.

4. Water Often

- Keep seed bed moist to enhance germination
- Water lightly (don't saturate) and frequently (at least once daily) until new grass is two inches high
- Water new grass regularly to keep roots moist

5. Helpful Tips

Mowing

- Don't mow until new grass is three inches tall
- Cut and maintain at 2 1/2 inch height
- Keep mower blades sharp to avoid tearing

Greening

- Use Greenview Fairway Formula Seeding Success or Starter Fertilizer
- Don't use a weed control product until grass is established (3 mowings or approximately 45 days)
- Fertilize lawn in the spring and fall

Weeding

- Don't use a weed control product until grass is established (3 mowings or approximately 45 days)
- Continue feeding with Greenview Fairway Formula Spring or Fall Fertilizers to maintain turf density and appearance

Pure seed vs. coated seed

Be sure when comparing your seed choices to investigate what the square foot coverage is for the bag you intend to buy. Pound for pound price comparisons are not apples to apples if you are considering uncoated seed versus coated seed or an all-in-one seeding product. All-in-one seeding products or coated seeds of the same bag weight do not contain as much actual grass seed, so you will get less square foot coverage.
