1. PREPARE THE SOIL

- A. New Lawns & Patch Repair
- . Loosen the top 2 to 3 inches of soil
- Remove debris sticks, stones, etc.
 Break up dirt clumps larger than a quarter
- B. Overseeding Existing Lawns
- Mow grass as short as possible
 Lesson top 1/4 inch of coil in bo
 - Loosen top 1/4 inch of soil in bare spots
 Remove debris and dead grass
 - Level areas where excess water collects

TIP: Use existing topsoil, as added soil may contain weed seeds. Remove any existing weeds and their roots before planting. Use a weed killer, if necessary, and allow sufficient time for it to dissipate before seeding.

2. PLANT SEEDS

Spread seed evenly by hand in small areas
Use hand or lawn spreader in large areas
Note: Not for use in livestock grazing areas.

· Level areas where excess water might collect

3. COVER SEEDED AREAS

Protecting newly seeded areas is one of the most important steps for seeding success when growing grass.

• Lightly rake seed bed so no more than 1/4 inch of soil covers grass seed

For best results, we recommend protecting the seeded area with GreenView® Grass Seed Starter. The tackifier and starter fertilizer in our biodegradable Grass Seed Starter pellets is designed to protect and nourish the development of strong roots, while holding on to moisture, to promote thick and healthy new grass growth.

4. WATER OFTEN

- Keep seed bed moist to enhance germination
- Water lightly (don't saturate) and frequently (at least once daily) until new grass is two inches tall
- Water new grass regularly to keep roots moist

5. MAINTENANCE

Mowing

- \bullet Mow only after $\underline{\textbf{new}}$ grass reaches three inches tall
- Cut and maintain at <u>3 inch</u> height
- Keep mower blades sharp to avoid tearing

PURE SEED VS. COATED SEED
