FALL LAWN CARE CHECKLIST

Aerate



Aerate in early fall.

Allows optimal recovery and root development before winter.



Make passes in a pattern.

Ensures that the entire lawn receives consistent aeration.



Aim for a depth of around 2-3 inches.

Allows adequate soil fracturing and minimizes stress on the grass.



Overseed



Overseed before fertilizing.

Enables newly seeded areas to take advantage of added nutrients.



Keep newly seeded areas moist.

Helps the seeds germinate and establish. Avoid over saturating.

Fertilize

Apply fertilizer in early fall.

Gives time for grass to absorb nutrients and helps grow strong roots before winter.



Follow application rates.

Over fertilizing can damage the lawn. Under fertilizing can lead to limited results.



Mow before fertilizing.

Helps the nutrients reach the soil more effectively.

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
